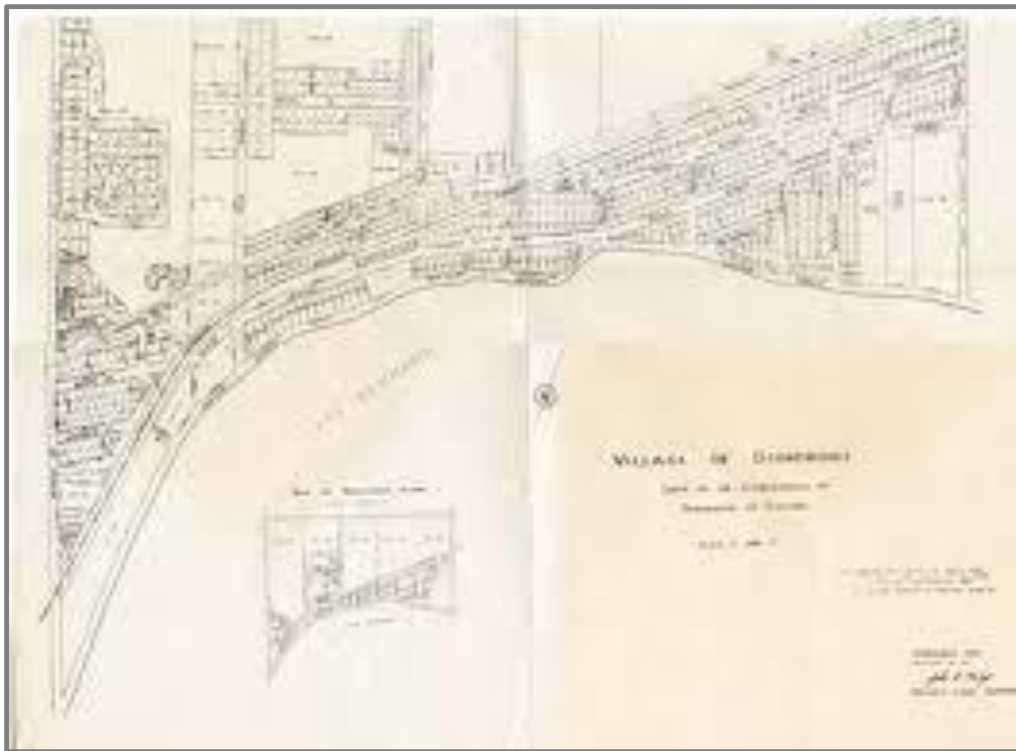

Municipal Heritage Register

The Village of Sundridge Municipal Heritage Register is the official record of cultural heritage properties that have been identified as being important to the community, consisting of:

- Properties designated under Parts IV and V of the Ontario Heritage Act
- Non-designated properties identified by Council as being of cultural heritage value or interest

The Register is a living document, meaning that that properties may be added to and removed by resolution of Council.

Heritage Designation

The Ontario Heritage Act enables local municipalities to protect and manage Ontario's cultural heritage resources. Part IV of the Act, entitled Conservation of Property of Cultural Heritage Value or Interest, provides for municipal designation of individual properties identified as having cultural heritage value. Both public and privately-owned properties may be designated under the Act.

All properties included on the Register are believed to have potential cultural heritage value or interest if their cultural heritage value or interest has not yet been recognized by their designation under the Ontario Heritage Act. Further research and evaluation may be required to comprehensively determine if a heritage listed property does or does not demonstrate sufficient cultural heritage value or interest to warrant conservation and designation pursuant to the Ontario Heritage Act.

How is a property added to the Register

To include a property on the Register, Council, must believe that the property has cultural heritage value or interest. Detailed research and evaluation of the property are not required to add a property to the municipal Register.
